**Codes of Conduct:** Our constitution has codes of conduct for Players, Managers and Parents.

We have had a large number of complaints with regard to children's language and attitude at training and games.

**If this carries on we will be asking some children to leave the Club.**

**Notify your manager early:** They have also been a marked increase in the late notification to managers or children not turning up for matches, to the detriment of all others involved. This has meant that some of our teams have been deducted 3 points, fined £10 and still have to play the cancelled fixture. A game cannot be called off if the league does not get a minimum of 28 days notice. If your child cannot make a game for school reasons or you are visiting/holidaying etc ***your manager needs to know***. We expect the same commitment from parents as you expect from the managers/officials of the Club.



The Club is always looking for more volunteers you are greatly needed..

Parents should involve themselves on match days; to collect subs, take down goals etc. More parents are turning up to home games. Ask your manager if the is anything that you could do to help the Team/Club.

**Club Charges:** As a Club we pride ourselves on keeping your costs down. This year the cost of registration is £10.00 per player (the lowest of all local clubs). The subs are £2.00 per game and ***we don't ask for training night fees*** (many other clubs do). During the season we pay to register with Devon FA, the DJM League, pay pitch fees and we have to have insurance for all of our teams. Which covers training, travel to games and playing, all of the managers have a copy of our policy. We also send our coaches and members onto relevant courses which range from £15-£300 per person.

**\*\*FREE\*\* Car stickers:** We have had a number of car stickers donated to the Club; they are a good way to advertise your support of the Club. Ask your manger for your car sticker.

**\*\*FREE\*\* Pitch Talk Magazine:** Recently a new magazine was launched aimed at youth football. It provides information for both parents and players alike and each month there is a two page spread on one of the local teams. We hope to get our teams into this magazine shortly, watch this space. The magazine is available through your managers. It is a glossy magazine which is full of good and informative details which would benefit all.
